Learning objectives

Intensive theoretical-practical course (20 hours) on the structure, functioning and activities of the most important international organization of a generally universal nature and with general political competence.

The course, a true full-immersion in the United Nations system, aims to provide a general overview of the structure and functioning of the UN, examining some significant and current thematic aspects related to operations for the pursuit of peace and the achievement of the objectives indicated in the **2030 Agenda**.

The lessons will be conducted by academics of notorious expertise in the specific subject and by international officials who will provide insight into the topics covered by experts.

At the end of the course, the participants will have acquired the cognitive tools to understand the whole dynamics of the Organization as well as to interpret the role of the United Nations as a global actor.
